

On June 17, the Culture Division introduced Anna Yin as the inaugural Poet Laureate of Mississauga. Anna will serve a two year term (2015-2017) as the City of Mississauga's Poet Laureate. The honorary position recognizes a poet who writes poetry or spoken word and has written on themes that are relevant to the citizens of Mississauga. The position holds four key objectives:

- * Serve as a literary ambassador for the City of Mississauga to audiences both within and outside of the City;
- * Promote poetry and literary arts within the City;
- * Raise the profile of writers in Mississauga; and
- * Create an artistic legacy through public readings and civic interactions.

Anna Yin is the author of five books of poetry including Wings Toward Sunlight and Inhaling the Silence. She is the Ontario representative for the League of Canadian Poets, been featured on CBC radio and has read her poetry on Parliament Hill. She is the recipient of several awards including the Ted Plantos Memorial Award, two MARTY Literary Arts Awards and the Chinese Professionals Association of Canada Professional Achievement Award.
